

For students arriving in France for the first time

Free Tuberculin Test

The **Anti-Tuberculosis Control Centre** of La Rochelle (in agreement with the University Health Service) offers a free TB screening for the students of the University of La Rochelle.

This screening is specially recommended to persons who may have stayed abroad recently; it does not have side effects and you can carry on practising sport after the test.

This screening, which helps detect the persons who have been in contact with the TB bacteria, consists in a tuberculin test (intradermoreaction) and requires two visits, the second one two or three days following the first one (an injection of the tuberculin and a reading of the test 2 or 3 days later) and if necessary a chest X-ray depending on the results.

The La Rochelle Anti-Tuberculosis Control Centre team will be available , no appointment required, on the premises of the University Health Service, at 44 Rue Albert Einstein :
